Highlights of 2018:

The Library was one of many local organizations to receive a generous bequest from the estate of Nathalie J. Fuller. An avid reader, Ms. Fuller is fondly remembered by Library staff for her daily walks to the library. She was a beloved elementary school teacher and her lasting legacy will ensure the Library and the Williamson organizations she supported are here for present and future generations. We are thankful for her bequest.

As a nod to future generations, the Library applied for a NYS Library Construction grant to improve interior and exterior lighting. The grant will assist with the installation of LED energy efficient fixtures as well as upgrading amenities in the Community Meeting Room. In 2018, Library meeting rooms were utilized by 201 local organizations. This was in addition to regular library programming and classes. We are thankful for all that use our space for civic engagement, parent and caregiver support, and life long learning.

The Library is also thankful for funding from Senator Helming and Senator Nozzolio that added comfortable seating and amenities to the Library's Teen Space and Adult reading areas.

The Library also had its first full year with fast speed fiber providing 10,528 visitors online connections with ease. The above coupled with 38,122 visits and nearly 75,000 check outs meets our goal of being a valuable community hub.
